Job Description

Purpose	Responsible for planning, developing, implementing and maintaining internally developed applications and interpreting business needs for the development team and acting as a first point of contact on our pentaho data platform, Platform X.
Responsible to	Head Statistician
Direct reports	N/A
Internal relationships	The job holder will work within the Statistics and IT Development department; will work closely with both the Research and Audit teams; and will liaise with other members of ICNARC.
External relationships	To represent ICNARC when dealing with application or development queries from external customers and other relevant individuals, bodies or groups; and to represent ICNARC at meetings, Steering Groups and Conferences when required.
Location/Environment	This role is based in Napier House, 24 High Holborn London. It requires regular travel including site visits and meetings, external conferences and training venues.

Principal duties and responsibilities

Leadership:

- To act as ICNARC's Pentaho expert and advise on future projects and development work. Support the development team in learning Pentaho applications and hold regular teaching sessions.
- Leading by example; sharing and developing personal expertise and knowledge and encouraging and supporting staff learning and development.
- To act as mentor for new and more junior staff by provide training and advice with application development systems and functionality.
- Foster an agile working environment for the development team and actively participate in regular agile ceremonies (stand-up, sprint planning, sprint retrospective, etc)

Applications Development and Management

- Act as the product owner for our Pentaho data platform, Platform X.
- Work with project teams to understand and identify requirements when developing of, or performing updates to, internal applications, especially those built with Pentaho tools.
- Lead the development of applications, working with project teams to:
 - produce detailed functional specifications for application development;
 - provide insights on other internal stakeholders and applications to ensure efficient design of final products which can meet the individual needs of multiple projects whilst maintaining rigorous data collection and validation procedures.
 - coordinate system testing, log and clearly communicate issues, and make modifications where appropriate;
 - define, programme and test applications to ensure quality and that new applications or features meet the defined business need and definitions of done;
 - develop written instructions and provide support and guidance on the use of applications to both internal and external users.
- Ensure applications with reporting functionality maintain integrity of data for use in both internal and external reports.
- Ensure applications continue to undergo agile improvements with incremental releases of new functionality and features to meet changing needs.
- Ensure internal applications are developed with privacy-by-design in mind and meet data protection and security regulations for the relevant purpose or business need.
- Attend internal project meetings, leading discussions on application development and clearly document and circulate actions/decisions relating to datasets/data management.
- Prepare/complete data integrity updates and ensure, where possible, that legacy datasets are updated in line with new data integrity decisions. Use data interrogation and analytical skills to investigate potential data integrity errors and propose updates and safeguards to existing and new datasets.
- Work with project teams to provide ad hoc reports and solutions for routinely required information/tasks.
- Provide Training / Workshops for our internal and external users of internal applications.

General duties and responsibilities as an employee

- To work as part of a team and contribute to the overall aims and objectives of the organisation
- To be an advocate for the organisation
- Attend staff meetings and training as required
- All staff are required to operate in accordance with ICNARC's values, policies and procedures, including but not limited to, Health and Safety, and Data Protection
